Method

- 1) In a microwave, melt the chocolate, butter and golden syrup and stir until smooth. **Please be careful as hot chocolate can burn**

- 3) Divide the mixture between 12 fairy cake cases and leave to set in the fridge
- 4) Drizzle with more melted chocolate and decorate whilst they are still wet enough to stick Yummy!

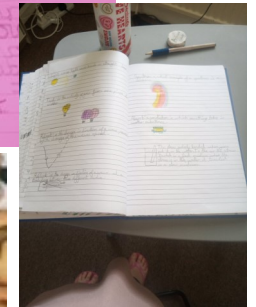

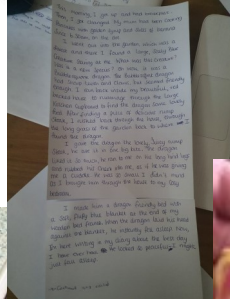
