Rice Krispie Cakes

100g milk chocolate & 50g dark chocolate(broken up)

100g Butter

4 tbsp Golden Syrup

100g Rice Pops (I used Rice Krispies)

EASY Makes 12

Prep: 15 MINS

Cook: 5 MINS

To decorate

50g melted chocolate


Sprinkles, marshmallows, nuts, Smarties, dried fruit or chocolate buttons

Method

- In a microwave, melt the chocolate, butter and golden syrup and stir until smooth. Please be 1) careful as hot chocolate can burn
- Stir in the rice pops until they are all completely coated in the chocolate. Divide the mixture between 12 fairy cake cases and leave to set in the fridge 2) 3)
- Drizzle with more melted chocolate and decorate whilst they are still wet enough to stick Yummy!
