Children Road Safety

Please can we remind you to **NOT** park on the yellow zig zag lines outside of the school entrance. This is to ensure that children can safely cross the road and are visible when walking and enables a clear view for drivers. Please try to park a little further away from the school and walk your children the last few meters to the school gate. We have witnessed and been made aware of a number of instances towards the end of this term where there have been some near misses involving children. Your help with this matter would be so appreciated.
