


Parents Meetings



Our parents meetings will be taking place during the week commencing 15 November 2021. Each teacher will be offering various dates and times enabling you to book either a face to face or virtual meeting. More information, dates and times will follow in the first week of Term 2.

In order to book your meeting you will need to use the Booking Service.



You will need to decide if you want to meet face to face or virtually (online).

You then choose the staff member you want to meet (your child's teacher).

Then choose the date that applies to the type of meeting you have chosen (face to face or virtual). Pick the meeting time that works best for you.

Remember you will need to do this for each child.

Once the above has been completed you will scroll down the web page to add your name, your email address, your phone number and your child's name.

Once you click book, you will be sent an email with either a join meeting (if it is a virtual meeting) or confirmation that your meeting has been booked if it is a face to face meeting.

You cannot book a meeting now—bookings will go live in the first week of Term 2

Dangerous Toys

A recent commissioned by the British Toy and Hobby Association (BTHA) found many of the toys tested could choke, strangle, burn, poison and electrocute children. Out of the 255 toys that were randomly selected, inspected and tested, 88% were illegal and 48% were unsafe for a child to play with.

The toys tested were bought from a range of online sellers. Currently, there is no legal requirement for online marketplaces to check the safety of the products that other sellers are listing on their site.

The report itself includes a list of toys that researchers found were illegal or unsafe.

As we move towards the Christmas season, you will be buying toys, and so the advice given in Appendix 8 of the report, Consumer Tips, could be especially valuable.

Germ Defence

Researchers at the University of Bristol have developed a website called Germ Defence that is designed to help keep pupils and their families safe from viruses liked COVID-19. COVID-19 vaccines and testing are really important for helping to control the virus, but there are still many other things we can all do to help keep everyone as safe as possible at home and at school - Germ Defence can help with this. You can access Germ Defence here After you've accessed Germ Defence, you can sign-up to take part in an optional survey and/or to talk to the researchers about your thoughts regarding Germ Defence. The interview will take up to 60 mins via phone/online and the participant would receive a £20 voucher as thanks for your time.

School Lunch

If your child is in YR, Y1 and Y2, your child is entitled to a free school meal.

All other children's lunches are to be paid for unless you are entitled to Free School Meals. You can apply **HERE**

Please check the criteria before applying.

Please ensure that lunches are paid for in advance. If you do not pay regularly, the lunch account will be blocked once the account reaches £11.50. You will be contacted to request payment.

You can pay online using a debit or credit card. Our payment service is Pay360 and you can obtain an account by emailing the school info@fva.clf.uk

Alternatively you can pay by cash—ensure the money is in an envelope with your child's name, class and the amount you are paying. Drop the envelope into the black letterbox in the main reception entrance.

Year 7 Applications Deadline—31 October 2021

Calling all Year 6 parents who have yet to complete the application for their child's secondary school place. The deadline is Sunday 31 October—click **HERE** to complete your application online

Applications and quick and easy to complete, with no risk of the application form getting lost in the post.

PCR Testing

If your child has COVID 19 symptoms

A High Temperature / A new and persistent cough / loss or change to your sense of taste or smell

They MUST take a PCR test—this can be booked by calling 119 or click HERE. They MUST isolate

A PCR test is a test that has to be sent away to a laboratory—it is NOT the test where the result is available in 30 minutes.

Please let the school know that your child has one of these symptoms so that we can monitor the potential spread of Covid within the school

Please ensure that a **negative result** has been received and that you have shown the school **before bringing your child in**, otherwise they may be placed in our Covid isolation area until we have received information from you.

What to do if you or another family member has Covid 19

From 16 August 2021, the government guidance states that anyone under the age of 18 and 6 months, or anyone who has had both doses of the vaccine, does not have to isolate if they are identified as a close contact of someone who tests positive for Covid-19.

You do not need to get your child tested for Covid-19 unless they develop symptoms.

Please do NOT ride Electric Scooters, Bikes, Scooters or skateboards within the school site - we want you to all be safe. Thank you.

Pokemon GO players can add each other as friends' in the game by sharing their troiner codes. Twe trainers who do this can then view each other's information, such as their username. If a username gives any closes to the player's real name at personnal details, a stranger may then be able to look them up online. The game also lets users upload images to social media, which could publich disclose a child's exact location.

IN-GAME PURCHASES

The game uses a currency called Pokecoins, which can be bought for real money (in bundes between 20.78 and 289.98) and exchanged for in-game Items such as Pokeballs and berries. It's extremely easy for a child to purchase Pokecoins (even accidentally) if there's a payment method connected to their mobile phone - and possibly rack up a streadle bill without realising it!
