Accessing Office 365

Open a web browser, we recommend Google Chrome but you can use others including Safari or Microsoft Edge. Your new tab or home page should appear, similar to the screenshot below:




In the address bar at the top, type in www.office.com as per the screenshot below:



The Office 365 front page should display, click on the orange sign in button. If



someone else is signed in the options may change, see image to right. You will need to choose 'Switch to a different account" if the address shown isn't correct.



The next page will take you to the sign in box, type in your email address here and then click the blue "Next" button.

Click on Teams for Live Lessons and Parents Evening

Children emails MUST ONLY be used to access TEAMS for live lessons, parents evenings and for submitting home learning to the teacher. Please DO NOT use your childs email address for any other communication.

Parents Evening is being held virtually on the 11/11/20 and will be via TEAMS, online. More information on how this will work and what you need to do will follow in the near future.

Good to know

- 1) Students in primary academies can not receive emails from outside of the CLF, with the exception of genuine Microsoft emails in relation to the service.
- 2) Students are prevented from sending emails to addresses outside of the CLF, this means that they can stay in touch via remote learning, seek support and submit work where required.
- 3) Address book settings have been set to only show people at the students individual academy so that emails won't accidentally be sent between sites from students.
