We are Readers

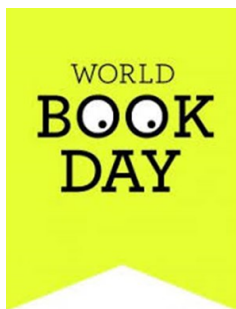

Parents can take their children at the end of the event

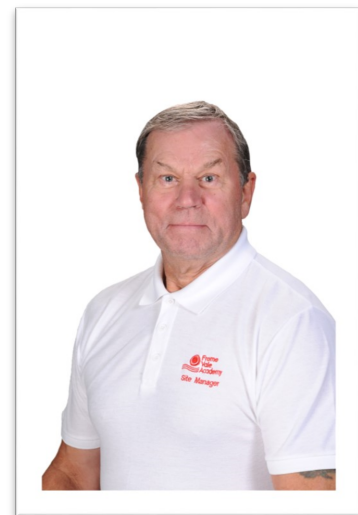


Lunch boxes
