We are Learners


We are Writers

We will start the term by looking at a new book called 'Traction Man Is Here' by Mini Grey.

We will be using this book, to develop our speaking and listening skills, building our writing by engaging in our every time we write features, which are:

- Finger spaces

We are Scientists

Our topic this term in science will be 'everyday materials.' We will be learning to identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials and explain why these are chosen for specific tasks based on their properties.

We are Mathematicians

As Mathematicians in term 2, we will be starting with 'comparison of quantities and part-whole relationships.' This unit will allow children to:


- Compare items according to various attributes, and develop the appropriate vocabulary and grammar to describe these comparisons
- Practice determining the quantity of objects in one or more sets
- Compare the number of objects in two or more sets, and use appropriate language to describe each comparison based on the context
- Learn to correctly use the appropriate mathematical symbols to compare quantities

This unit will also introduce equivalence (the same as) and will lay important foundations for later work on calculation and algebra.

We are Mathmagicians

Our mathmagicians sessions are designed to be a highly visual number fact teaching programmes, which supports children to develop a deep understanding of number and number relationships, and fluency in addition and subtraction facts.

This unit within our mathmagicians sessions will support children in developing their ability to make and break numbers 6, 7, 8 and 9.



We are Frome Vale Citizens

This half term our Frome Vale Citizens topic is 'celebrating difference'. We will be learning about

- The same as and different from
- What is bullying and what should I do if I am being bullied
- Making new friends
- Celebrating difference and celebrating me

Our learning behaviour is 'collaboration' and our value is 'fairness/justice'.

During this term, we will visit our school display boards.

We are Designers

As Designers, we are going to learn about 'structures' this half term. Our exploration of this topic will allow us to discover, define, develop, deliver and evolve a tower.
