We are Writers


This term we will read another book called 'Lila and the Secret of Rain' written by David Conway and Jude Daly. We will continue to develop our character and setting descriptions, to make our writing more interesting and engaging to the reader.

Using this book, the children will be working on present tense (simple present) and joining two independent clauses with and.

Following this book, we will look at non-chronological reports and will write our own focusing on Kenya and elephants.

We will continue (as always) to include in our every time we write features, which are:

- Full stops
- Finger spaces
- Presentation / Handwriting / Letter formation



We are Mathematicians


In mathematics we will explore Additional and subtraction facts within 10, numbers to 20, and unitising and coin recognition.

Across our learning, we will know key mathematical facts, recalling them quickly and accurately. There will be opportunities for logical thinking to derive the correct problem-solving strategy. And we will promote children's thinking to find a way to apply their knowledge and skills to answer unfamiliar types of problems.

We are Mathmagicians

Our mathmagicians sessions are designed to be a highly visual number fact teaching programmes, which supports children to develop a deep understanding of number and number relationships, and fluency in addition and subtraction facts.

This unit within our mathmagicians sessions will support children in developing their ability to recognise number neighbours, 7 tree, 9 square, and strategy selection.
