We recommend 10 minutes every day to really give children the best opportunities to develop their confidence in reading. I will also read with them on a rotation of days.

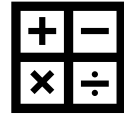
We are Writers

In Term 1, our writing will be based around the fiction text *Arthur and the Golden Rope*. Over the term, We will be using this text as a stimulus for a variety of writing tasks such as character and setting descriptions and writing our own adapted narrative. In addition to this, we will be writing to inform, through a non-chronological report about the Anglo-Saxons.



We are Mathematicians

In this term, we are going to be extending our understanding of number and place value. In this unit, we are going to be reading, writing, comparing and ordering numbers to 10,000. We will move on to addition and subtraction of 4-digit numbers using formal methods which require exchanging.

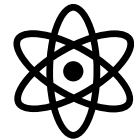


In order to build and maintain number fluency, we will be consolidating our mental and written arithmetic skills throughout the term in our Mathsmagicians sessions.

We are Scientists

This term, we are studying Chemistry. Our focus will be states of matter.

In this unit, we will learn about the different states of matter. We will compare and group solids, liquids and gases. In addition, we will investigate how states of matter change through heating and cooling.



We are Athletes

PE will be taught twice a week, on Mondays and Thursdays. Please ensure that children come into school wearing their school PE kits on these days. Please label all items of clothing clearly.



We are Historians



In Term 1, we are going to study the Anglo-Saxons. In this unit, we will learn about why the Anglo-Saxons came to Britain. We will also learn what life was like in an Anglo-Saxon settlement and analyse artefacts found at the Sutton Hoo burial ground.

We are Artists

In Term 1, we will be focusing on drawing. Having explored famous artists who have produced drawings, we will create our own and display them in our termly Art Gallery.



We are Home Learners

Each week, children in Year 4 are expected to:

- Read to an adult at least twice and record it in their yellow reading record
- Play TTRS for a total of 20 minutes
- Learn the weekly spellings for the test on Friday
