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
Reception - Term 2

Reading

We encourage you to read with your child every day.

The books we send home will match the current phase we are teaching in school.

When you have read with your child, please leave a note in your child's reading record.



It is important that reading records are in school every day and they will be checked throughout the week.

If there are any questions about your child's reading, the books they are accessing or any concerns, please do not hesitate to get in touch.

Phonics

In Reception, we follow the scheme Unlocking Letters and Sounds. It aims to build children's speaking and listening skills, as well as preparing children for learning to read by developing this phonic knowledge and skills.

Last term, we started learning our phase 2 sounds. Your child should know:

Set 1: s,a,t,p Set 2, i,n,m,d Set 3:g,o,c,k Set 4: ck, e, u, r Set 5, h, b, f, ff

This term we will be learning the remaining phase 2 sound and moving onto phase 3.

Please practise the sounds learned so far with your child at home. Video's are available on our Wordpress site.



Writing

This term in our writing sessions we will be focusing on the following books





We will be focusing on writing initial sounds and applying our phase 2 knowledge to our writing.

We will be continuing to practise writing our name.

- Shapes with 4 sides
- Night and day
