


Reception – Term 1		
<p>Reception</p> <p>Welcome to Reception!</p> <p>The children have made a brilliant start to school. Some of the provision areas in our classroom include loose parts, message centre, small world, creative area and reading corner. We have been spending lots of time outside, enjoying the big space we have to explore.</p> <p>If you need to talk to the class teacher, please feel free to arrange to have a talk at any time!</p>	<p>Reading</p> <p>We encourage you to read with your child every day.</p> <p>For the first few weeks, we will send home books for you to read and share with your child. This is to develop a love and understanding of reading.</p> <p>The books we send home will match the current phase we are teaching in school.</p> <p>Please leave a note in your child’s reading record after you’ve read with your child.</p>  <p>It is important that reading records are in school every day and they will be checked throughout the week.</p> <p>If there are any questions about your child’s reading, the books they are accessing or any concerns, please do not hesitate to get in touch.</p>	<p>Phonics</p> <p>In Reception, we follow the scheme Unlocking Letters and Sounds. It aims to build children’s speaking and listening skills, as well as preparing children for learning to read by developing this phonic knowledge and skills.</p> <p>With two adults in the classroom, we will be able to have two phonics groups running at the same time daily. Both groups will be focusing on the same sounds and practising the skills taught. Phonics is taught from the first day your child starts Reception.</p> <p>The sounds your child will learn this term:</p> <p>Phase 1 – Listening skills</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Drumming - Initial sounds - Musical instruments <p>Phase 2:</p> <p>Set 1: s,a,t,p</p> <p>Set 2: i, n, m, d</p> <p>Set 3: g, o, c, k, ck</p>
