- Children reading non-decodable books can independently change their reading books in the morning.


We are Writers

We will be using this book, to develop our speaking and listening skills, building our writing by engaging in our every time we write features, which are:

- Capital letters
- Full stops
- Finger spaces
- Presentation / Handwriting / Letter formation



We are Athletes

We have Forest skills on Wednesday morning and PE Friday afternoon. Please ensure that your child attends school in their P.E kit.

We are Mathematicians

In mathematics we will be counting within a 100. This will be a very practical block of learning.

We will be:

- Counting forwards and backwards
- Counting irregular arrangements
- Understanding more/fewer
- Counting one more/ one less
- Identifying smaller numbers within a number
- Partitioning

We will promote children's thinking to find a way to apply their knowledge and skills to answer unfamiliar types of problems.

We are Historians

As historians our key concept focuses on the question 'How do we know what has changed in our society?'

We are learning to sequence events on a timeline and describe generations.

We are Home Learners

- Reading practice (ideally daily; a minimum of three times a week)
- Play Numbots online (20 minutes per week)
- Practise spellings in preparation for Friday spelling test
- Practise phonic sounds and common exception words covered in school.

We are Frome Vale Citizens

This term our Frome Vale Citizens topic is 'Being me'. We will be learning about:

- Being special and safe in our class
- Knowing that we belong in class
- How to make a class a safe space for everybody
- Recognise how to be proud of an achievement

We are Scientists
