### **We are Readers**

Please ensure your child brings in their reading book and reading record every day. You should read with your child at least twice a week and record the date, title (book or other reading material) and your comment.

### **We are Mathematicians**

In Maths this term, we will be completing the unit of adding and subtracting across 10. We will then complete our unit of 'Numbers to 1000.'

During our Mathsmagician lessons each morning, we are revising our learning that we have previously looked at in year 2.

Our multiplication learning will be supported by regular times tables practice. Please ensure your child is practising their TTRS using their individual log-in details at least three times a week. If you are unsure on how to do this, please catch me at the end of the day or message me on Dojo. Practising at home is vital to learning all the multiplication and division facts. By the end of year 3, children will be expected to instantly recall their 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables related division facts.

### **We are Frome Vale Citizens**

This term's learning behaviour is '**Aspiration and motivation.**' FVC value is '**Respect.**' Our Jigsaw focus is 'Being me in our world.'

### **We are Historians**

As Historians, Year 3 will be exploring events surrounding the Tudor period (**AD1485 – 1603**).
