We are Geographers

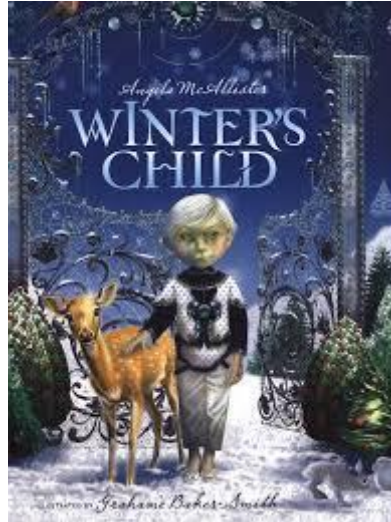
Create an information leaflet about Bristol to persuade people to visit here.
